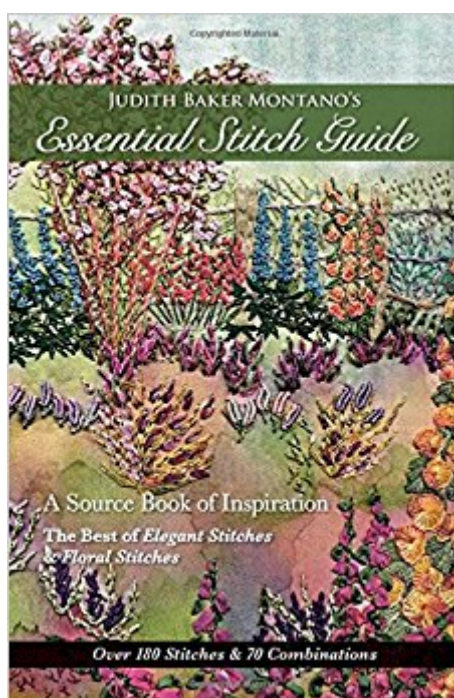


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# Judith Baker Montano's Essential Stitch Guide: A Source Book Of Inspiration - The Best Of Elegant Stitches & Floral Stitches

If you are a fan, or are new to Judith Baker Montano, you won't want to miss her latest book *Judith Baker Montano's Essential Stitch Guide*. This book is exactly what it says: an essential stitch guide. Montano has combined over 180 stitches and 70 stitch combinations found in her two previous books, *The Best of Elegant Stitches* and *Floral Stitches* into one easy to carry with you book. For those of you just starting your embroidery journey you will find a wealth of information on getting started with the basics. Subjects range from fabrics, needles, overlays, threads and embroidery techniques such as Silk-Ribbon embroidery, Punchneedle embroidery to working with beads and using other mixed media to create the mood for your piece. You will also learn about the proper way to insert your fabric in a hoop as well as how to transfer and enlarge designs. Finally there is also a section on washing your finished work and blocking and pressing. Judith urges you to "think like a

painter—when designing your own work. How to use color to its best advantage and the best methods to compose your piece are also covered. With 180 stitches you will have an encyclopedia of stitches to choose from. Every stitch is illustrated and the instructions are easy to understand. I enjoyed reading the Crazy-Quilt Combinations chapter. In this she combines several different stitches to create a repetitive design to work along a seam line. They could also be used to decorate any number of projects. Of course I would be remiss if I failed to mention the Free-Form Embroidery chapter. Here is where all your stitching skills are put to the test creating needle art collages. You will combine everything you have just read in the book to create a beautiful piece of work such as a landscape or a seascape or just add dimension to a project you have already started. This book is a rehash of Judith Baker Montano's *Elegant Stitches* and *Floral Stitches* into a single book that contains some content of both books. I have had the original books in my library for some time and they are frequently used. The content of these books is wonderful, but the publisher has put a cheap cover on this book that was already curled by the time I got it from . Do yourself a favor and get the original *Elegant Stitches* and *Floral Stitches* through a second hand seller like Ebay to have copies that will last the test of time.

I am so happy to see the revitalizing of interest in embroidery. I love this art form and whether you are new or old to this technique, and if you can only have one book (that's not me, but I'd love to meet her or him!), this is the one. I've loved to death my copy of *Elegant Stitches*, but this one will provide you with the path to take your work to a whole other level. Ms. Montano documents every stitch imaginable, but she also provides instruction of variations to many of the stitches. She also covers stitches for varying materials, such as wool and silk ribbon. The last part of the book builds on the foundation of the front; combining stitches and further variations and then images and ideas. In the last part of the book, Ms. Montano breaks down many of her pieces of art so get a very clear, easy to understand insight into her creations. She also provides drawings and notes so you can incorporate these elements into your own work. The book is spiral-bound, so pages will lie flat while you work. The instruction is easy to understand and includes plenty of step-by-step images.
