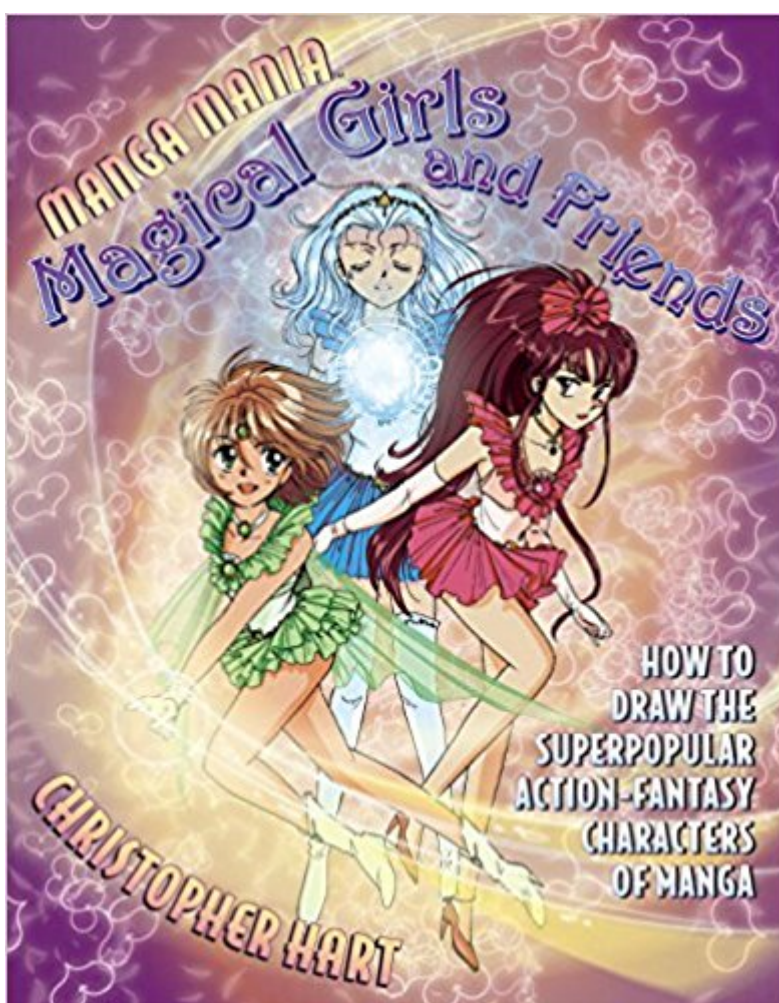

I really like the different designs/ costumes there are many different stuff in it for example: pets, animals, a lot of nice drawings, bases / basics, lots of pages, how to draw, boys, villains, girls, even how to make manga, different kind of characters, eyes, faces, different clothing, breaking down stuff so it's easier, different sizes and types of people, and types of clothing, varieties and like/ almost everything you need to make magic/fantasy manga, some extras I guess, and ect. I don't know what else to say but that it is nicely packed with stuff (even though there are some things I know or don't care) and nice and plentiful of awesome drawings. I would recommend this to someone familiar with manga but really needs help and it also could be for some normal or intermediate missing some stuff. Actually, I think it's for everyone. Since it's full of awesome drawings, this can be a good reference since there is a lot of variety. It covers so much!

I highly recommend this book for those who are drawing magical girls series or even if you are making a fantasy series as well! I found this book very helpful. It gives you great information about how you should draw their eyes. There are many other useful sections in this book which includes a section on magical boys (which I was very pleased with. It is hard to find a good drawing manga book that helps you learn how to draw them), it shows you how to do transformation sequences, how to draw the popular sailor school girl uniform, and many more. I think this is one of Christopher's best books he has done. This is a book you should get if you are making a magical girl series or just a fantasy series.
