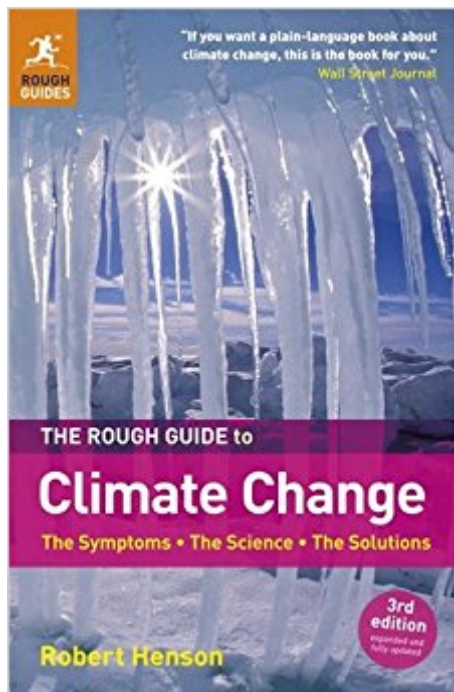

Part 3, "The Science," is so clear that even a retired who almost most flunked biology can understand it (me, of course). An annotated list of "Books that Have Global Warming at or Near Their Center" is a great resource for lay readers. Henson has been writing for UCAR/NCAR for over 20 years and it shows.
