

This book is easy to read. I bought this for some students who would not enjoy reading the Iliad otherwise.

This is a great primer for the epic poem. I enjoyed this version of the Iliad-much easier to get through all the battles and fighting!

I thought perhaps a children's version would be a good way to do a 'cliff notes' summary of the Iliad - but this was the WRONG book to use. You needed a full knowledge of all mythological figures to follow as well as very disjointed story. Would not recommend.

I realize The Iliad can be a difficult read, even in a good English translation. And I realize that adaptations are necessary for younger readers. But this adaptation is not well-written at all. The prose is wooden, more a recitation of events than the retelling of a great story. My sixth grader was assigned this version to read at home. My wife and I agreed that it's not engaging at all. No wonder kids don't want to read the classics, if this is the kind of introduction they get.
