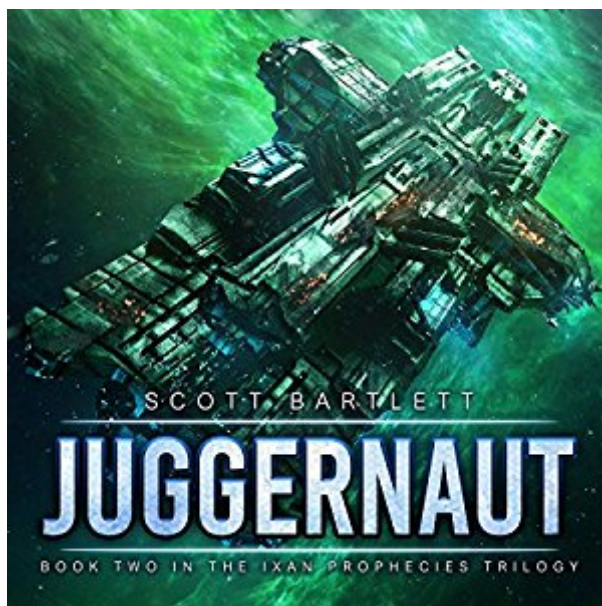

Okay, I must admit -- after reading JUGGERNAUT, I immediately purchased and read RECKONING. Couldn't stand it. I HAD to know how it ended. So with that out of the way--A supernova. Something not to have thought possible in their lifetime. But here was Epsilon Leonis, hurtling towards Campion, the home of Earth inhabitants since Earth had been utterly destroyed. Captain Keyes, Lieutenant Vin Husher, Festy, and the rest of the faithful crew of The Providence are faced again with danger from the enemy -- known and now some unknown.
