

Rabbi Monique Goldberg was ordained by the Schechter Rabbinical Seminary in Jerusalem. She contracted polio at the age of two and spent most of her life in a wheelchair. Rabbi Goldberg worked as a Research Fellow at the Center for Women in Jewish Law at the Schechter Institute. She co-wrote or co-edited ten books or periodicals. Rabbi Diana Villa was born in Argentina and holds an M.A. degree in Jewish Philosophy at J.T.S., a degree in Psychology from Buenos Aires University and rabbinic ordination from the Schechter Rabbinical Seminary. Rabbi Villa lectured on Jewish philosophy and rabbinic literature at the Seminario Rabínico Latinoamericano in Buenos Aires for over eleven years. She is a senior researcher at the Center for Women in Jewish Law at the Schechter Institute and the co-author of *Za akat Dalot - Halakhic Solutions for the Agunot*

of Our Time . Rabbi Villa is active in finding solutions for the agunot issue. She is currently a lecturer in Talmud and Jewish Law and coordinates the Mishlei program at The Schechter Rabbinical School.
