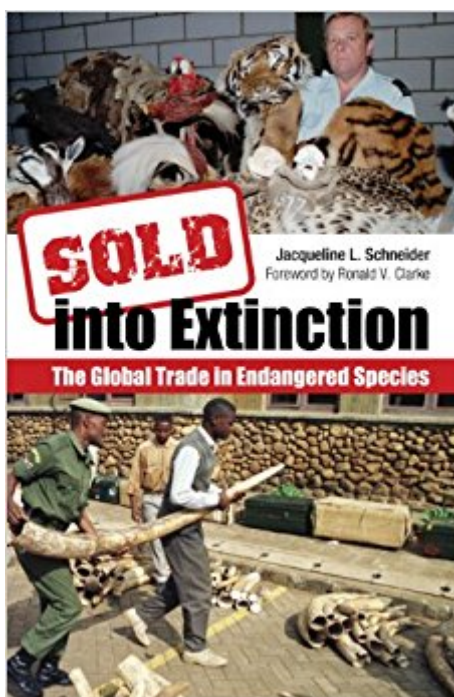


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Sold Into Extinction: The Global Trade In Endangered Species: The Global Trade In Endangered Species (Global Crime And Justice)
