

I purchased this book because I'd always been curious about what the Bible "really" says, being a 20th-century-born, English-speaking, American non-Jew/non-Greek, and thought that it would at least be a good intro into biblical scriptive insights. This book delivers what it promised: complete detail of each one of the twenty-two Hebrew letters':1. Design, with historic commentary citing;2. Numeric equivalent, with examples and good intro toward Gematria;3. Meanings, with excellent TaNaK-based citings. It doesn't highlight the alef-beis sounds; I think the author's target audience was NOT a graphologically-curious Gentile. But I nonetheless found this title extremely informative, detailed, researched, and awe-inspiring. Thanks be to G-d and this book's author for disclosing this information! "Mem" is the word here!
