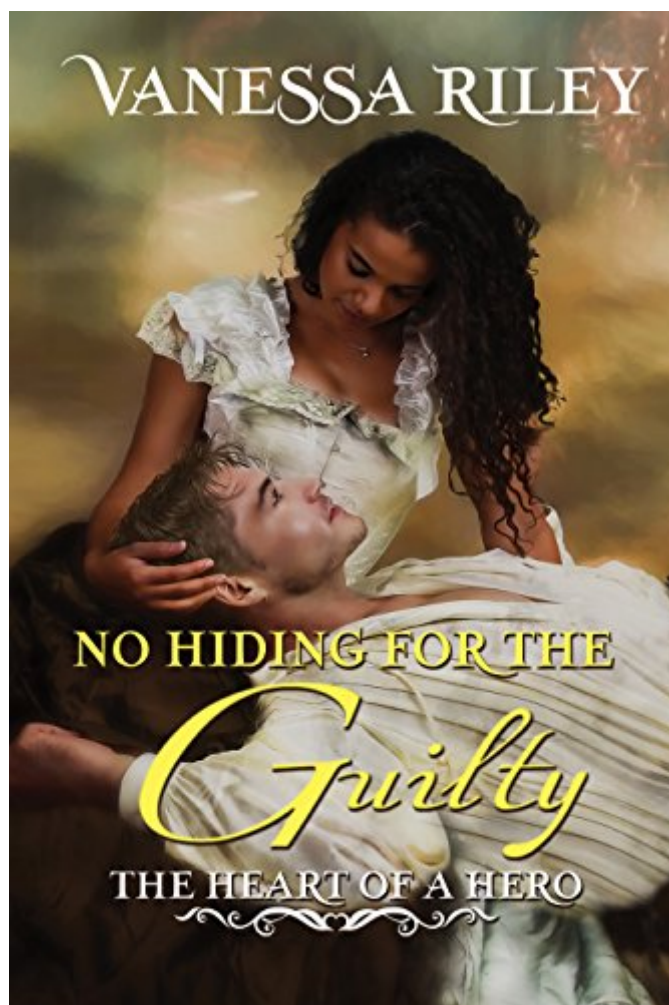

This is a good solid 4 star story. Mystery and romance and two engaging...ok, more than two engaging characters.
