The scenery and world building was fun throughout. Cohen was interesting and we find out a lot about Britta's history and family along the way too. Turns out, her father kept several secrets from her. I liked some of the slow burn with her and Cohen but I got bored of that after a while too. I loved the writing, the only thing keeping it from 5 stars is it was just a little slow at times. But the ending changed everything for me. So now, I'm super intrigued. The last 10% is pretty action packed and things definitely didn't go as I thought they would! Overall, I totally recommend this if you're looking for a fairytale-esque fantasy!
