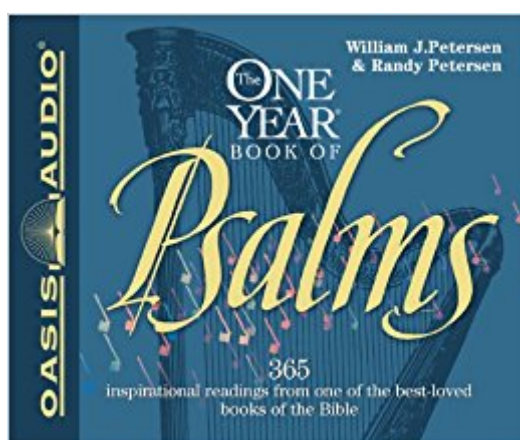


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The One Year Book Of Psalms: 365 Inspirational Readings From One Of The Best-Loved Books Of The Bible (Christian Perspective)

I've made it through 3 months so far, and I'm very much liking this devotional. While I don't care for the version of the Bible used, that's a problem in the majority of Christian books these days, and one I easily solve simply by reading the text in my own Bible. I do enjoy the commentaries for each day's devotion; I find them thought provoking, bringing out parts of the Bible text that I hadn't really thought of and really getting me to think about what I'm reading. This approach to the Psalms opens them up to me on a level I hadn't really approached before, hitting home and becoming very personal. I especially like the cross-references they have after many lessons, asking questions and having the reader go to other texts to really bring out the topic they were teaching; this isn't an approach I've seen done too often in many modern devotionals. This one has some substance to it, and isn't just another "read part of a verse, then read a cute little story about being a better person" kind of devotional; I found the *One Year Psalms* to be a true devotional with a solid biblical foundation.

I have been reading this volume since the new year. I wanted to stop this morning and write a word for the day the author might do a revision. My reluctance in giving you a better rating is just in the translation you chose. Had you have chosen any of the formal equivalency translations it would have greatly enriched this volume. My trust in dynamic equivalency is weak at best. If ever you do a revision I would like to request the ESV or another in that line of translations. For those of us who believe strongly in the words as well as the thoughts that follow it would greatly enrich and enhance this volume. Thank you for what you have written. I choose to add to this at the June mark of my reading. The author has chosen an immoral actress as an illustration of excellence in her field. At this point I am dropping this book from my reading.

Have been reading this book on my Kindle almost daily for a few months now and enjoy the pace and insight of this reflection on the selected Psalms. After having read a number of different devotions to a few members of my Sunday School class and my Bible study, I have ordered two 'paper' copies to gift two particular friends and will likely order a few more copies. I also read Sara

Young's "Jesus Calling" and Oswald Chamber's "My Utmost for His Highest" most mornings and this Devotional fits in nicely before I begin my class preparation.
