As a gay, black, bigger girl, Cheyenne's life is hard. Her family does not support her sexuality. Her classmates bully her and the school administrators place all the blame on her. Cutting has become a refuge for her, a way to control her pain; it has also become something else for her to be embarrassed by. This is an important story for any teenager who has felt confused, anxious, depressed, or worried that they don't fit in. Issues of

religion, race, tolerance, self-harm, and bullying are dealt with in this short story. When it ended, I wanted it to go on so I could learn more about Cheyenne's life. Hopefully Watson will do a sequel or follow-up.
