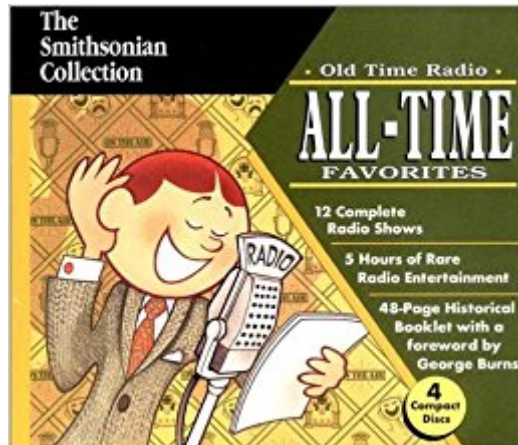

ALL-TIME RADIO FAVORITES. The collection was originally released as a 5 cassette set by Radio Spirits. There were three thirty minute shows per cassette. They could have easily fit 3 shows unedited, but instead chose to delete commercials and shorten program closings - all the while passing them off as 'complete shows'. Don't waste your money on this mess.

This is a great collection of what made radio such a creative medium: all the action is "seen" by your "mind's eye"!
