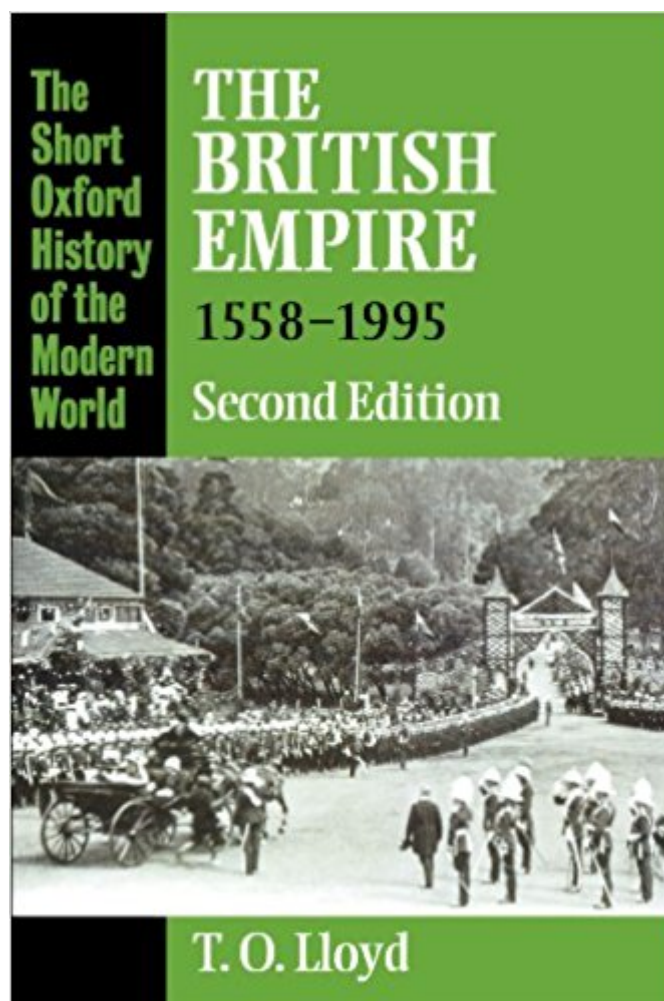


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The British Empire 1558-1995 (Short Oxford History Of The Modern World)
