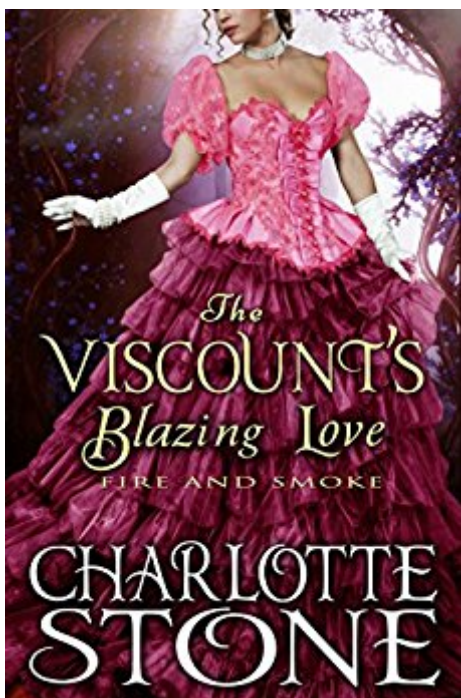

My Thoughts: As expected from this author this is another well written and sweet romance. I have now read 4 books by this author under 2 pseudonyms. All have been very well written with believable characters from the time period. To me this just goes to prove that some romance titles do not have to be filled with sex and violence to be good. This one does have an underlining hint of violence that had occurred in the past but no true violence in the storyline. It is this reader/reviewer's opinion that this book deserves a 4.5 out of 5 star rating for storyline and characterization and 1 of 5 flames for heat. I have enjoyed reading this author's work and would recommend the read to anyone over the age of 15. With the lack of actual sexual and violent scenes it is suitable for a teen audience and would enrich their knowledge of the time period.

I really didn't think this series could get any better, then I read this one. It was outstanding! It can definitely be read as a stand alone, but the first two books in the series introduce all of the characters and explain the back story as it continues with this book. This is Jane and John's story. They have been friends since they were very young. While they love each other, John, not having been born into an affluent family, feels that he will never be good enough for Jane. I was heartbroken at their parting. I could feel every painful and anxious moment they both experienced. I

so wanted them to get together as they were perfect for each other. I won't spoil the ending, but I have to say that I cried. Rarely does a book evoke such an emotion in me. Charlotte Stone is simply a marvelous author. I'm not sure what is next in the series, but I am ready for the journey.

This is a continuation of the *Wardington Park* series of stories about the Duke of Wardington, his sons and his friends. In this book, Jane (the sister of one of the Duke's son's wives Catherine), has been having a "love affair" with John, a commoner who lived on the estate, the son of a man who never amounted to much, and was a mean drunk and horrible to his family. Because of his unhappy upbringing, he cherished his friendship with Jane, and loved her from afar. The reason for Catherine's burns from a childhood fire is revealed, causing family drama and the crashing end to the love affair between Jane and John, which started when they were children, and continued to adulthood. They manage to get past it, and fittingly, the story concludes at Christmastime. Very well written, enjoyable book. It helps if you've read the others, but it's not totally necessary.

This is the story of Jane and John, and it also brings us up to date on Charlotte and Ben, as well as Skip and Julia. We first met these characters in the two previous books in this series, which began with a devastating fire that destroyed Charlotte and Jane's home. John and Ben played major roles in helping the Watsons escape the fire. When Ben married Cat, they took Jane to live with them. So there was suddenly a very wide difference in Jane and John's

circumstances. This and many other things, both real and imagined, kept the two of them apart. But there were some delightful twists and turns ahead for Jane and John. Another fantastic book in this series, very highly recommended. I was given a free copy of this book and voluntarily wrote this honest review.
