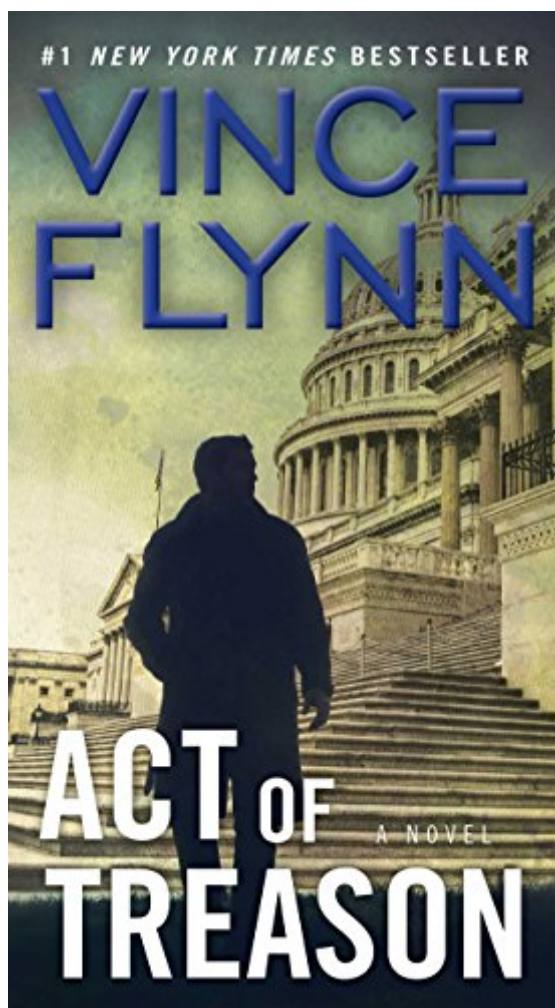


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Act Of Treason (A Mitch Rapp Novel Book 7)

No biggie but it struck a discordant note in the book that the author seems to think Cyprus is a province of Greece.

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
