

I purchased the digital edition of this book as an aid to study for the CSP. It does a great job of summarizing most of the formulas and knowledge areas on the tests. Some of the chemistry stuff could have been explained better, but you can supplement with khan academy videos. If you are weak in a certain area you may want to get a book pertaining to that specific subject,in addition, but you cannot go wrong with this purchase. This may be an issue with the kindle app I have for my iPad but the links in the table of contents do not work.
