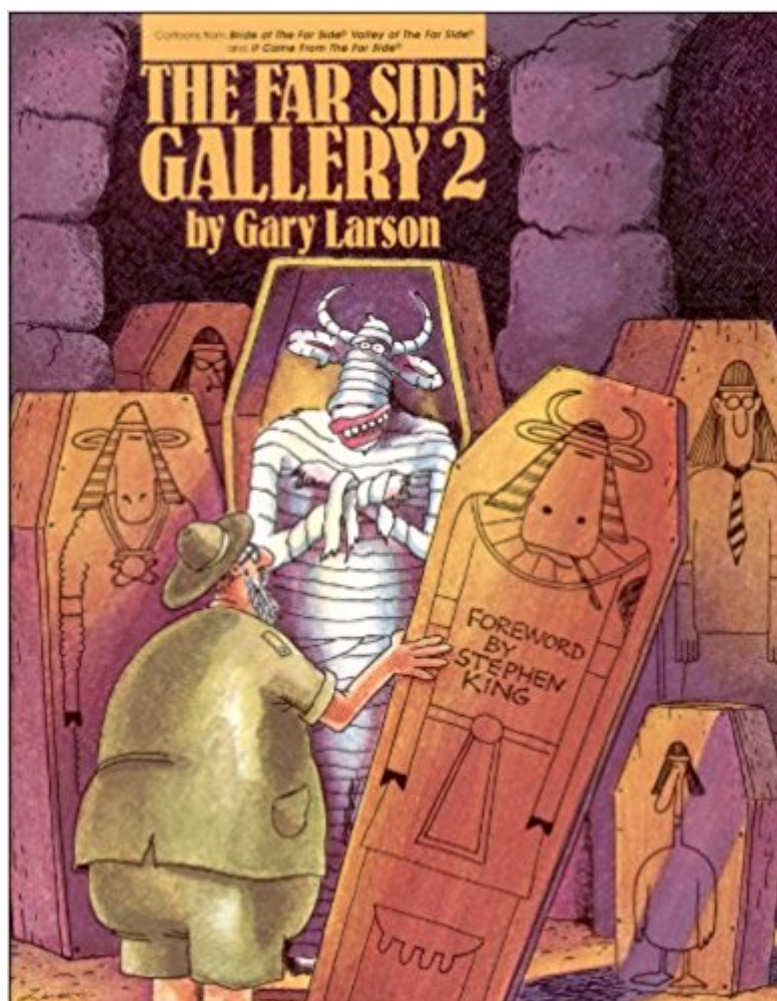

The Far Side was syndicated in more than 1,900 daily newspapers from 1980 to 1995, when Gary Larson retired. During its run, the cartoon spawned 22 books from AMP, which were translated into a total of 17 different languages. For his work with The Far Side, Larson was awarded the Reuben Award for Outstanding Cartoonist from the National Cartoonists Society in 1991 and 1994. The group also named The Far Side Best Syndicated Panel in both 1985 and 1987.

Gary Larson is a brilliant cartoonist. He creates single panels that comment on the ridiculousness of the world, tell an entire story in the most minute details, and are full of imagination.

Got as a gift for nephew who likes Far Side comics. I like them overall too. Some are funny, some not. It may all be what strikes you at the time.

I've loved Larson for years but have only ever had one other book of his cartoons. I bought this one as a little gift to myself and have enjoyed every moment of looking through the cartoons. Larson uses strange situations and animals to poke fun at humans and the human condition. Very funny. If you haven't seen Larson cartoons before, you shouldn't miss out any longer.
