

I ordered two books based on customer reviews on the web site. This book was exactly what I was looking for - extremely comprehensive, up-to-date, and very useful tips on how to spend my time and money wisely. The reviews in the other book by comparison could have been written by the providers themselves and were comparable to what one finds in a free city guide. With so many hotels, the information cannot be as comprehensive with as many different opinions as one can find on the travel web sites. Nevertheless, the authors make the best use of the space available. I highly recommend this book for anyone trying to get a handle on the great range of options that Las Vegas offers. It was the perfect book for me and exactly what I was looking for.
