

This book is somewhat smaller (6.5"x9.25") than I anticipated, and kind of thin (3/8"), but that's not really a bad thing once one has this in hand. Not many of this genre are that large anymore, maybe due to the economic state of things today. However, in the limited world of truly fabulous ocean liner books, this is one of the nicer ones in terms of images we haven't seen before. Its a cute little edition for my collection. The descriptions are nicely placed, offer many new insights, and anyone could enjoy it.
