

The CITIX60 series provides guides to some of the world's most renowned design hubs - cities that lead the world in culture and design. Curated by a select group of local artists, designers, chefs, architects, musicians, photographers and filmmakers, this is an insider's view on what makes a trip to the city memorable. They include up-to-date recommendations on the accommodations, eateries and shops that give each city its distinctive flair, and a handy section on travel tips gives basic information on getting around, as well as unusual tours and recurring festivals to help better plan your trip. Detailed maps and QR codes provide ease of travel, and a blank pages section at the back of the book with lined and gridded pages allows for note-taking and sketching.

I'm heading to Japan for two weeks in October. I've already been twice before, and have spent a cumulative 15 days in Tokyo over the course of my trips. Not only did I manage to miss nearly everything listed in this book, I hadn't even heard of most of them. Even without having used this

book in the wild, I can tell that its suggestions are right on the money because the locations listed inside are in the same vein as the places I've visited and loved in the past. I flagged all of the spots I don't want to miss this time around and ended up with 15 must-sees. Content aside, the craftsmanship of the physical book is a joy. It's not clear from the preview images on , but the book's cover image is actually a delightful poster that you can unwrap and even frame. The paper is thick and hearty, and the images (of which there are many) are all in bright, clear color. The drawings in the first few pages are cute, the book is exceptionally portable, and contents are easy to navigate. There's even an index. If you appreciate authentic, earnest, local culture but don't have a hip Japanese friend to lead you by hand through the city, you can't pass this title up. My only regret is that Viction Workshop doesn't have a similar title for Kyoto. Get on that, guys!

I've been planning my trip for Tokyo next year for weeks now, but found that I spent way too much time trying to find reliable tips from sources that knew Tokyo inside and out. This book which is curated by creatives is great at giving you tips in all sorts of categories (architecture, shopping, food & restaurants, hotels etc). It's easy to understand, graphically simple to find exactly what you're looking for! I especially liked the first few pages which gives you basic information such as public transport links, useful websites, apps and other very useful tips! I thought the book would be a regular sized book, but to my relief it was small and portable making it perfect for bringing with you when you're out exploring Tokyo!

The book is good if you like art/history, etc. It really depends on your tastes. Too bad there are no directions to any place listed in the book so you'll have to do more research before going.
